Day 1

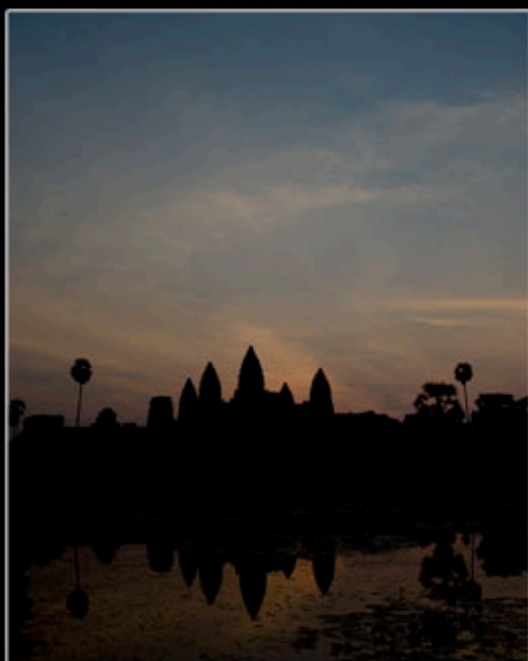
Arrival, introduction and welcome dinner at the hotel

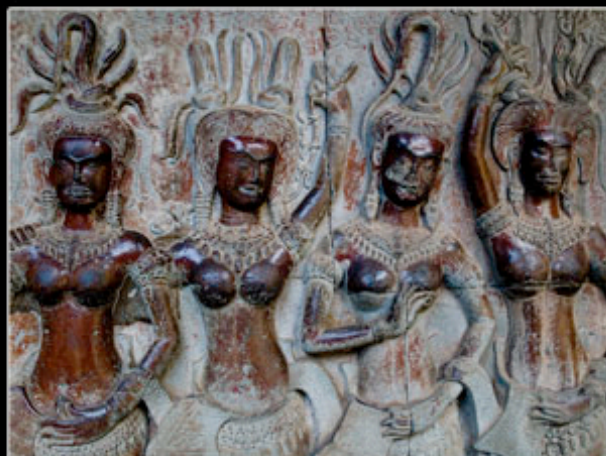


Day 3

Visiting the countryside near Siem Reap with its rural villages, local markets, scenic pagodas. We'll have a workshop on portraits before lunchtime.

In the afternoon we will take a boat to a floating village for some life-on-water sceneries.

Evening free to spend.



Day 4

Ta Prohm (Angelina Jolie temple) at dawn followed by Ta Som, Victory Gate, Terrace of the Leper King and Angkor Wat (lunch)

Afternoon and evening free to spend.

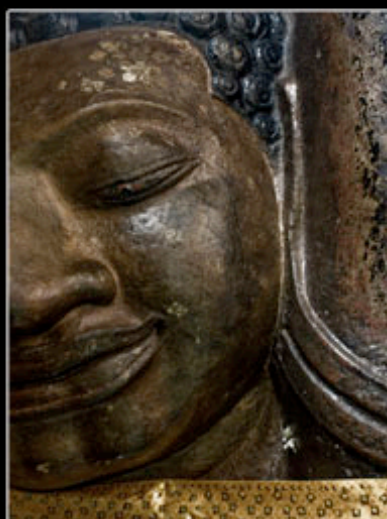

Day 5

Early morning trip to Banteay Srei and up to Kulen Mountain. We spend the rest of the day at the holy mountain for visiting and exploring The River of the 1000 Lingas, the reclining Buddha, the waterfalls (where we have lunch)

In the evening we're out for dinner at a typical Khmer restaurant.



Day 6

Roluos Group is our start this day before going by boat to Kompong Khleang, a concentration of houses on stilts on the lake. After lunch we'll go back to Siem Reap. In the afternoon we'll have a post production workshop followed by a farewell bbq and a presentation of our work taken during the tour.

Accommodation

Some facts on Cambodia

CLIMATE

Cambodia has 4 seasons:

- December until February, cool / dry
- March until May, hot / dry
- June until August, hot / wet
- September until November, cool / wet

The rainy season, June until November, shows a regular pattern; cloudless in the morning and rainfall for 1 till 3 hours in the late afternoon or early evening. The country side and temples of Angkor are particularly picturesque during the wet season.

MONEY

US Dollars are widely used.

Credit cards, like Visa and Master Card will be accepted in most hotels and banks.

ATM's have arrived in Cambodia.

These international ATM's accept credit and debit cards and will provide you with US Dollar notes.

VISA

To visit Cambodia, a Cambodian visa is required for most nationalities.

Cambodian visa's are available on arrival at most international entry points including the international airports at Phnom Penh and Siem

Reap and over land borders crossings

The official prices for Cambodian visas are:

- Tourist visa (type T) USD 20,- (and 1 passport photo)

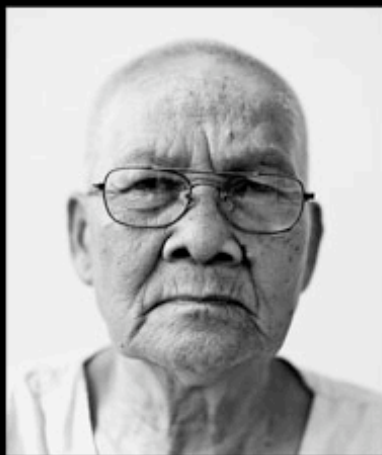


About the photographer:
